CSv2 Training

- Goal
 - ▣ Series of one-day trainings
 - Minimum of one training per region
 - 10 regions
 - Train 80-90% of cancer registrars
 - state and regional registry registrars, facility based registrars
 - approximately 400 cancer registrars statewide

Category: Clarification

Subject: Grade - Noninvasive Urothelial Bladder Tumors

Effective: Cases Diagnosed 1/1/2010 Forward

For **noninvasive** bladder tumors, assign code 9 [unknown] to the Grade field. This applies to only histology codes 8120/2 [Transitional cell (Urothelial) carcinoma in situ] and 8130/2 [Papillary transitional cell (Papillary urothelial) non-invasive carcinoma].
