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
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The Problem

darker shade equals higher goal



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Could approval process be made more uniform across registries?

Proposed criteria for study to receive executive approval

- Peer review
- Federal approval
- Adequate funding
- Annual documentation that data are maintained in a secure and confidential environment

- Use laptop
 - With AHS-2 file on it
 - To do linkage
- Delete your registry file from laptop before leaving
- Can be done with or without supervision by your registry personnel
