a. Volume V Revision TF report – Sandy Considerable work has been done in improving Volume V including additional diagrams, CAP Checklist and SPM segment. Final edits to the HL7 section are being done by Ted. There will be supplemental document to address the CAP structure data capture forms and templates. The group feels they should continue to meet to address rapidly changing path issues.		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Lori H. recommended the group review issues identified, as well as develop objectives and goals for moving the committee forward.
b. Edits Workgroup Report – Jim Version 18D will be available in 2 weeks.		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Jim will be added to next month's agenda to give a more detailed report.
c. Interstate Data Exchange Guidelines – Lori H. A taskforce has been working on revisions/updates to the Interstate Data Exchange Guidelines. These have been submitted to the S&RD workgroup for review and approval. Lori H. went over the guidelines and pointed out there will be a minimum data item set that goes along with this document. The accompanying spreadsheet includes 2 columns they would like to add to Standards Volume II Required Status table for Interstate Data Exchange. A column was also added to identify suggested edits that could be used with the Interstate Data Exchange.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Add the text "Although not all registries utilize the type M record to the 3rd bullet in section 3.7 Identification and Tracking. Lori H. discussed with Jim creating a standalone metafile of current edits needed. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The guidelines were approved with minor changes. Lori will notify the Interstate Data Exchange group of the minor changes made before forwarding to the Board for approval. When Lori H. receives the formatted version back from Mike Bykowski she will forward to the NAACCR Board for approval.
d. 2018 Readiness Survey results Lori H. reported 44 responses were received and she shared some of the results. Frank Boscoe will be summarizing the March and July results. The summary should be complete by the next S&RD meeting.		

<p>e. Update on cancer informatics group Gary and Eric have agreed to co-lead this group. They are in the process of structuring the goals, objectives and members. Ideally, they would like the group up and going by the end of year.</p>		
<p>f. Researchers issues with Data Standards and Data Dictionary (Volume II) – Isaac Isaac has heard from multiple sources the Volume II website and information available on the website needs work. The formation of a taskforce was suggested to revamp resources available for NAACCR Volume II data, making the data more consumable by others. Some issues:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Easier navigation • Easier data extraction • More structured data dictionary information • Semantic interoperability <p>Eric attended a meeting of the group OHDSI. They are developing a OMOP common data model for any healthcare observational data. There is a focus area for oncology and they are looking for assistance from NAACCR in using the data dictionary for a highly structured way to represent all of the cancer registry abstract. All agreed this would be great, but complicated. The Cancer Informatics group sees this as a potential project once the group is formed.</p>
