a. Physician Reporting WG Report – Wendy B.					
<p>The primary focus has been on implementation of the NAACCR 18 changes needed for the eMaRC Plus tool. This tool was developed by NPCR provided to states for pathology reporting and to process the physician's CDA documents that are received from EHR. Along with focusing on new requirements and mapping rules. Version 7 of eMaRC Plus was released the beginning of March. We will start meeting again soon to discuss, gather and prioritize the next round of enhancements. Focus will be on the user experience, providing better reports and usability of the data. Small subgroups have been meeting with EHR vendors. Wendy estimates 30 some states have been receiving physician reports. There will be training at the NCRA Conference about how to get reports out that may be more useful to the states.</p>
