- Central registries post their edits metafile and/or instructions concerning their metafile
 - Must be logged in to MyNAACCR account to view metafiles
 - Start with v22A
 - Anyone with MyNAACCR account can download metafile and/or instructions

Must be logged in to view metafiles!

A MyNAACCR account is required to view posted metafiles, upload metafiles, download metafiles, or to subscribe for notifications.

The NAACCR Edits Clearinghouse provides a space where central registries can share their central registry specific edit metafiles with other central registries, software vendors, and users of their registry metafile.

Central Registries are strongly encouraged to post the most current version of their central registry metafile beginning with v22.

- Multiple metafiles can be posted as well as documentation related to the metafile.
- To post your metafiles and/or associated documentation, use our [Metafile Upload Portal](#).
 - If you choose to not upload a metafile, you should still post a document explaining where information concerning the metafile can be found and a contact person who can answer question concerning the metafile.

Submit a Metafile

- Individuals must have prior approval to post.
- Email ID is contact email that will be included on portal.
- Multiple documents may be posted.
- Comments are for webpage admin only.



Welcome to the Edits Clearinghouse Upload Portal

Please use the fields below to upload your registry specific edits metafile and associated documentation. At this time we ask that only v22 edits metafiles and associated documents be posted.

- In order to post file, your MyNAACCR account must be associated with the central registry selected in the "Select Central Registry" field. If you are not able to upload a file on behalf of your registry, please email us at info@naacccr.org
- The name entered in the "Name" field will show on the Edits Clearinghouse table. The name will be hyperlinked to the email address entered in the "Email ID" field. The name and email address should be the contact person for edit related questions at your registry.
- Multiple metafiles and multiple supporting documents may be uploaded.
 - To upload multiple files click the first file to be uploaded and then press and hold the Ctrl key. While holding Ctrl, click each of the other files you want to select. All documents to be posted must be selected at this time.
 - The next time you upload files, all files that have previously been uploaded will be removed.
- Text entered in the "Comments" will only be seen by the webpage administrator. Comments or instructions meant to be seen by users of the Edits Clearinghouse should be added to a document and uploaded with the metafile.
