<b>a. EDITS WG Report – Jim</b> The group is currently in the final testing phase of v22b and should be posted by the end of the month. There will be a training for central registry edits meta file administrators on March 31 <sup>st</sup> . Work has begun on v23.						
<b>b. Non-Hospital Reporting – Deb/Lori K.</b> Lori K. sent the Minimum Reporting Data Set team charter and work plan to the group and reviewed on the call. Small changes were made as suggested. There was considerable discussion regarding possible minimum data sets. Lori H. sees the development of a minimum data set to inform cancer incidence as needed so we can define what is the bare minimum that we consider an incidence case to be counted. Then that minimum data set could inform what would be considered a minimum data set for radiology, physician, and path reporting. It is likely each of those various reporting sources would have other data items that would be considered part of their minimum data set, but they would have to at least start with that core minimum set for incidents.						
<b>c. Cancer Informatics Advisory Group update – Eric/Gary</b> The next meeting is tomorrow, and agenda includes the question from Randi regarding why researchers want data faster. They will also be discussing timeliness.						
<b>d. Mid-Level Tactical Group updates – Lori K./Deb</b> New data items were voted on at the last meeting as well SSDIs. The surgery codes had a split vote and the SSDIs passed. There was a revote for some of the items which has not been tallied yet. A vote was also taken on a WHO change that Lois presented, but the results are not yet known.
