a. Minimum Data Set TF report – April/Sean April reviewed a spreadsheet the TF has been working on and asked for further direction moving forward. The TF has representation from central registries, RDU SC, standard setting agencies, etc. There was some discussion regarding the use of unknown values for the data items. Wendy mentioned from the NAACCR Board perspective, this progress looks great and will be shared at the next board meeting. Lori K. stated this is the first step in a long process. Randi said for a future consideration the SC may want to look at what data items are required for different data sources. b. Interstate Case Ownership TF report – Lori K/Wendy Lori reported the group is finalizing a white paper with an estimated completion date of June.					
c. Volume III TF report – Fernanda Fernanda presented slides on the progress. A list of contents is being developed and deciding how the hub will work. She shared the web pages on the NAACCR site they are considering using as the "home page". The group is considering using the new Data Standards and Data Dictionary page as a template for Volume III hub. The group is working on updating the charter and recruiting leads for each category. They would like to kick off the first meeting of the task force leads at the NAACCR Annual Conference in New Orleans.					
d. For Discussion document – Randi Randi shared this topic came up at her registry when discussing creating their VPR file and thinking about the ability to release and rerelease data for various studies. She outlined many possible issues and wanted an open discussion about how registries address these issues differently. Many expressed the questions are very pertinent.					
e. Cancer Informatics Advisory Group update – Eric/Gary The CIAG is discussing topics that came from a HLSG in-person meeting. For example, what is the AG's role in interoperability and national initiatives (e.g., ONC standards and USCDI). Sandy Jones has developed a crosswalk between various standards and the CIAG discussed how they might be involved in some of these
