Discussion Items <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Pathology Reporting WG report Josh shared there were several member changes: Rich Moldwin is the new co-chair, both Ashley Knealing and Samantha Spencer joined the group. Sandy Jones, a long-time contributor to the workgroup, announced her retirement, which was met with appreciation and well wishes. Currently the group is addressing some HL7 balloting copyright issues. Inter-registry Data Exchange guidelines Lori H. reported that the group has completed the Inter-Registry Data Exchange Guidelines. Questions from S&RD that Lori H. will take back to the group: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Need to clarify which registries can sign the data exchange agreement, particularly regarding international registries. Cancer Informatics Advisory Group report Eric presented the CIAG list of priority areas, which included structured treatment regimens, molecular reporting, US Core Data for Interoperability, potential data sources for enhancing registry data, and large language models. The group identified potential issues with Odyssey data and molecular reporting and structured treatment regiment, suggesting a need to assess the risk and develop a long-term strategy. The group is also working on a genomic reporting manuscript. Partial Records Heather provided an update on partial records, announcing plans to convene a focus group to develop a charter for a partial records task force. Valerie Somma, Eric Durbin, Valerie Yoder, Rich Pinder, and Randi Rycroft volunteered to join the focus group. Mid-Level Tactical Group report Heather reported that MLTG has submitted their recommendations to the HLSG on the v26 proposed changes. MLTG is finalizing the charter for the ICD-O-4 Task Force. 				<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cancer Pathology Reporting name changes for the WG and the guidelines were approved by the group. Remove Cause of Death from critical data items, some registries are restricted from sharing that information. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Lori H. to add inter-registry data exchange guidelines to the April SC meeting agenda. Lori H. to coordinate the first meeting of the partial records focus group before the next SC meeting.
