Central Cancer Registries an Essential Overview session – Randi Randi reported that this pre-conference workshop was cancelled due to low/no registration; however, Randi plans to finish work on the slides. Value of population-based cancer surveillance – Randi The SC discussed the Board request to provide a definition of population-based cancer surveillance and provided examples of challenging issues that cancer surveillance helps to address, how registry data are used, how registry data are used for rare cancers, etc.		After much discussion regarding the definition the SC agreed to leave the three definitions that could be potentially used depending on the audience. The SC agreed there are potential examples that can be pulled from the March Coffee Break, reaching out to central registries, cancer control/prevention, and or comprehensive cancer centers. 6. High quality registries document – Randi The SC reviewed the Traits of a High-Quality Registry document and made a few revisions.		There was clarification that this document will be shared with the NAACCR membership, not with the public. The Advocacy section is for Advocacy and Outreach. The metrics section is a list of metrics in addition to the current certification criteria.
