<ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Lori shared with the group the NAACCR Board is holding the budget request for Blue Book online subscriptions due to the changes within SEER including the retirement of Lois Dickie. b. Jenna introduced Valerie Yoder as the new co-chair of S&RD. 						
3. Discussion Items						
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. SSDI WG report Jennifer Ruhl updated the group on the progress of the SSDI WG. Currently there are no major projects. The WG is working on two new AJCC v9 protocols for 2026 and three new SSDIs. They are also working on the P16 SSDI. Jennifer discussed the difficulty SSDI is having with the lymph node size for head and neck. Donna elaborated on the difficulties. b. Edits WG report Jim mentioned that they are testing v25b and it should be ready by May 9th. He also mentioned that they have started work on v26, scheduled for release August 2025. Jim also clarified that the new edits should not require genEDITS v6. c. Inter-registry Data Exchange guidelines Lori shared the last TF meeting focused on updating section 2 of the document regarding agreements with registries outside the US. The TF added a statement to address concerns about sharing data outside the country and removed Cause of Death from the list of critical data items. The document was reviewed and approved by the SC. d. Birds of a Feather topic Ashley sought suggestions on a topic for Birds of a Feather to be held at the June NAACCR conference. She also requested volunteers to lead the discussion. Randi suggested the topic "Doing Less with Less" and discussing potential efficiencies that have been successful. Monique Hernandez was recommended to potentially lead this and Monique agreed. e. Cancer Informatics Advisory Group report Eric mentioned the departure of Dana Rallison from Moffitt and the CIAG. Eric reported on the ongoing manuscript about molecular reporting and the group's highest priority, which is to gather more information about the potential abandonment of NAACCR standards by Odyssey and OMOP. He also mentioned a planned discussion with CIAG and OMOP about collaborating more closely moving forward. f.
